I am in receipt of your letter of the 19<sup>th</sup> inst. enclosing the first entry report, and sketch of midship section, of the new steamer "Jane Clark", and with regard to the discrepancy which appears to exist between the depth from the top of the floors to the top of beams as stated, and the registered depth, I beg to explain that the discrepancy is more apparent than real; the Registered depth being taken in the Boiler space where there is no ceiling; the lowest part is a little abaft the middle of the vessel's length, where the depth is about as stated in the report.

depth in the report.
