Glasgow for same post.

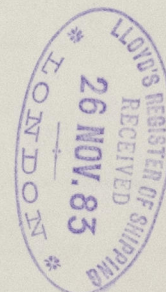

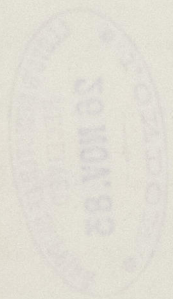
