The vessel is nearly completed, as far
as the hull and equipment are concerned,
the only things requiring attention are, - the
closing in the openings over Engines and Boilers,
the pumping arrangements; and the After
peak tank to be retested, on account of
the stern tube leaking at the bulkhead.

advised as to the above.

of Freeboard to this vessel. - A Report of Survey
for Freeboard" will be sent on with the
Report

on the vessel, as soon as the particulars
of Register Tonnage and dimensions are
received from the Board of Trade.
