

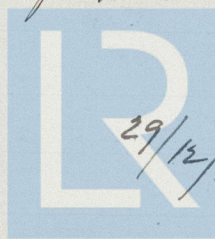
Steel Sailing Ship "India" built at

The report & section should be made
to agree as regards the size of the
keel stem, stempost & gunwale angle steel,
and the extent of the reversed frames
in way of the forecastle.

There ~~is~~ also a slight discrepancy
between the depth to top of floor plates & the
registered depth.
