Sir,

In forwarding my report on the S.S.  
"Susannah Kelly" I beg to state that the  
reason for not doing so before was on  
account of the incompleteness of fittings  
to the tanks, the owner having taken the  
vessel out of the builders hands before  
a sounding pipe & angle iron on end of  
tanks could be fitted, there having been  
some dispute between them which has  
ended in litigation. I have this day  
seen the owner concerning these points  
& he has promised to have them done  
at an early date & at the same time  
other alterations will be effected which  
will alter the vessel's tonnage.
