I beg to inform you that the Screw
Steamer "Pioneer" recently built at this Port
& owned by Richard Foley Esq of Cork has
sailed with the safety valves of the main
boiler adjusted to slightly too high a pressure,
they lift at 210 lbs per sq in instead of at
205 lbs. The vessel will be at Cork in
a day or two, will you kindly see that the
valves are readjusted to lift at not more
than 205 lbs per sq in.
