In reply to your letter of yesterday's date having reference to my report on the S.S. "Star of New Zealand", I beg to state that the depths from top of floors to main and upper deck beams are given on the report from the bottom of floors; these depths should be 19' 9" and 28' 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ " respectively; and the thickness of the face plate to the hold stringer should have been $\frac{13}{20}$.
