Survey during construction the Empire
Boilers of the American Iron Works
"Kamaura Marine" built & tested
by the Iron Works Co. of New York and intended
for classification.

The boiler of the Empire Iron Works
is a plate boiler made of steel, the
heating and all other details
which are made of steel. It is a
single boiler which has previously been
inspected while being built.

The steel boiler of the Empire Iron Works
was tested according to the
requirements in force at the time
of its strength with an internal pressure
20% in 3 inches. The boiler was
then tested to failure at an internal pressure
(400 lbs) in 3 inches. The boiler was
applied to the service of the Empire Iron Works.

a Special Act Certificate has
been issued along with the Certificate
of Class.

In competition the machinery &
boilers were tried on a full
power and satisfactorily reported
upon to the Committee.
