REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE, FOR Completion, as per letter received from the Belfast Surveyors on 31.5.97.

The permanent closing in over the Engines and Boilers has now been completed. Steam steering gear fitted aboard, and tried under steam. The deck pumps examined & tested. Water-tight doors examined & found in working order. The fresh water tanks tested under water pressure and found satisfactory. One set of sails, consisting of one fore & one main trysail, one jib & two staysails, now placed on board.
