With reference to your telegram of to-day's date regarding S.S. "MARTE" ex "PARKSIDE", I beg to state that the after peak head is watertight, and that the leaks occur round the frame as at the chocks, also at the stern post at the top of tank.

The vessel is now lying at the Tail of the Bank, off lock, and Mr. Kerr is proceeding there to examine same and will you whether the tank has been satisfactorily cut off by the fitting of a blank flange, which the Owners' representative is going to have done to-night.

The report on the machinery has been forwarded to you, as requested, and the First Entry report on the hull is returned to Belfast for our Surveyors there to complete.
