Messrs Harland and Wolff Ltd  
(builders of the vessel) survey the steel  
screw steamer "DEVONIAN" of  
Liverpool, for the purpose of ascertaining  
whether, and to what extent, damage had  
been sustained to the bottom plating in  
launching the vessel on 28 June 1900.

In examining the vessel in the  
Canada Docks Liverpool on 7 September  
the undersigned found on port side, in  
way of fore hold, the plating on bottom slightly  
ruined, but the plating undamaged.

Recommended that the bottom be  
haunted where necessary, to place the vessel  
in the same good condition as before the  
accident.
