Sir,

I have to confirm my telegram of this afternoon, addressed to the Society's Surveyors at Cardiff, as follows, viz;

"Request Scullard proceed Milford Haven tonight survey
"steamer PARIS now in graving dock water is to be let into dock
"tomorrow forenoon letter follows addressed to Scullard at the
"vessel, Committee".

With regard to this case, I have to state that you should carefully examine the vessel with a view to your afterwards issuing a certificate (if you are in a position to do so) that the vessel is in your opinion in a fit state to proceed in tow to Belfast where she is to be permanently repaired.

I have to add that the certificate should be made out in the form of a special damage survey report, and a few of these forms are enclosed for your use. A copy of the certificate issued should be forwarded to this Office for reference.
