The alterations of erections, as approved, are nearly completed, and I expect

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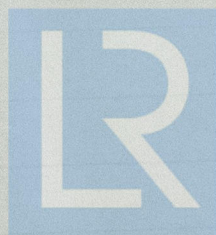


I expect to be able to forward my
