" Good noon possible your report of ship repairs
for classification on Thursday vice charter
pending. Croft.

As vessel wants chains sails etc: is the report
uncomplete. Ready three weeks. Vessel all
deals unusually strong good materials. Sub-
mitting A. 1. soon years. Croft probably your
office obtaining information.

whereafter the committees valuable answer was
received containing order of sending the report
when the vessel was ready. I expected this order
and was indefinite about to send my mentioned
telegram, but not willing that the owner of the
vessel should have any reproach I resolved to do so.

The man who on my behalf has been at the repairing place for about
two months and inspected the whole work finished declares that
the vessel as to be seen in the registerbook is from an earlier

building date, has been tore down 13 feet from the
keel and renewed in all parts, whereafter I have finished
the report as if the vessel was new built. He explains that
although he in a long train of years has commanded
vessels in all parts of the world and built vessels before
he has never seen such an excellent supply of materials
and well done work as on this vessel on which nothing
has been spared, the builder with the greatest politeness
condemning all materials being pointed out to the
Inspector, and in several cases supplied with larger
dimensions than the rules require.

According to these informations I dare submit to
the honorable Committee of granting the vessel A 1
of nine years.

I hope the report will be to the satisfaction
of the honorable Committee.

NB The chains of the vessel are not yet arrived but Certificate
for the one from Tiptons Testing Comp. has been received.
As soon as the chains arrive I shall have the pleasure
of writing you on account of the owner. I would
not keep the report any longer thus gaining time for
the owner.

At the same time I have the pleasure of forwarding
Mr. G. Schoning two reports of repairs ^{summed up} held on board the S.S. John
W 17 Decr. "Channing" and S.S. Diana which vessels both struck
on a rock about the same time. The S.S. Diana had
just as known by the Committee received new
Certificate when she on her next voyage got the in
the report mentioned damage. The amount of

charges is to be credited the honored Committee to
the end of the year.
