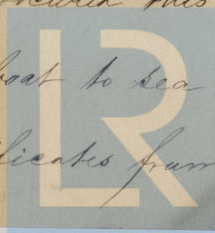

Dear Sir,

We make free to wire you today as follows,  
"Please don't register 'Fæderlandet.' Letter past."  
The reason of our request is this, that the 'Fæderlandet'  
has actually in a kind of way been taken from  
us by the principal, or corresponding Owner, Mr. Halvorsen.  
He declined to settle for the vessel, a sum of some  
kr. 10,000 being still outstanding, and until he paid  
us the amount we would not yet him the Builders'  
Certificate. He then procured this Certificate in an  
other way and sent the boat to sea. - We have accordingly  
kept back the Certificates from Lloyd's, & if you

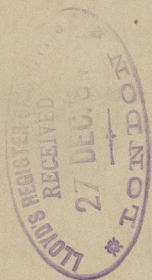


now kindly will decline entering the vessel and your
