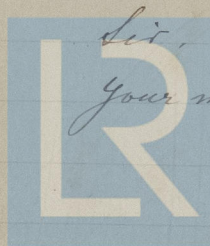

Sir,

I am obliged for your reply to my letter of the 14th inst. & now beg to submit for the Committee's kind consideration, a more detailed report on the above named vessel. — The Rules, Sect. 54, Survey No 2 have, with one exception, been fully complied with & in addition the outside planking near Stem & Sternpost has been removed from Plank-sheer down to abt. 6 ft below the load W.L. marked on Mid. Section; also removed some Ceiling inside right forward & aft to ascertain the extend of Dry Rot, which was found not to reach lower down than abt. 1 foot below load Waterline. — The only condition not complied with is the removal of a stroke of decks next the waterways & I trust the Committee will not for this reason decline to class the vessel as the ends of the beams were, through the removal of the outside planking & defective top timbers, completely exposed & examined & have been found sound & good. —

I have to add that the fees stated on the enclosed Report have not yet been paid to me, I shall receive same by the time the Certificate reaches me. If you will kindly post the same not later than Friday evening, I can deliver it just in time before the vessel is leaving. —
