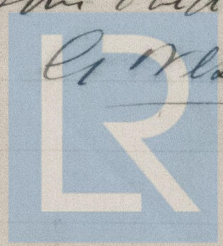

worth Barge William Gorden of my report  
NO 2608, This vessel is metal fastened  
up to one fifth of the depth as required  
by the rules with the exception of the  
Keel and Keelson bolts which are of Iron  
The Stern & Stern Post both are of Metal  
The Limber, bilge and Iron Ribs, both are  
of Metal driven through and clenched  
and the Iron Bolts in the Ship above the  
metal are to all appearances of Galvanized  
The bolts in Crutches Breastwork are of  
Metal driven through the outside plating.
