It is submitted that before this case receives the consideration of the Committee it should be pointed out to Mr Rule—who held the survey jointly with the Appraiser Surveyor—with reference to the sketches just received showing the drilling of the shell plating that the shearstrake is $\frac{3}{16}$ " less & all the remaining strakes $\frac{1}{16}$ " less ^{amidship} than their original thicknesses. and in view of this he should be requested to state whether the results of the drillings may be considered as representing the general condition of the plating ^{whether they} or have been taken in locally wasted places.
