SIR,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 26th instant respecting the case of the bk. "ADOLF TIDEMAND"; and in reply thereto, I have to acquaint you that it will not be necessary for you to write a First Entry report on this case.

The plating should be drilled as required by the rules and in such places as to indicate its general condition, and you should forward to this Office a sketch of the drillings for the consideration of the Committee, and you should at the same time, state whether, in your opinion any doubling should be fitted or other compensation made for deterioration in the plating. You should not wait until the survey has been completed before forwarding this sketch.

Mr. Scullard, one of the Society's Surveyors at Cardiff, is being instructed to join you in the survey of the vessel, and I have to request that you will arrange to let him know when the ceiling remaining to be lifted and oxidation have been removed; the plating drilled as required by the rules and the vessel otherwise prepared for examination.
