The S.S. No. 3 ^{partly held at Rio in April 98} has now been ^{completed} held, and the following repairs

done (due to wear tear):- Main Deck renewed from stern to poop; 14 poop side plates, 2 counter, and 1 fore-castle plate renewed; a number of rivets, one yard of some running gear renewed; main hatch lower hold partly renewed. Cement made good or minor repairs.

The shell plating has been drilled and in consequence of some deterioration the strake below sheerstrake doubled for about 90ft each side.

It is submitted the vessel is worthy to remain classed *A1

with record of Survey 1.99 and notation of S.S. Apl
