It is submitted the Appledore Surveyor be informed with reference to his letter of the 28th instant that it will not be necessary to write a first entry report on this case, and that Mr. ^{one of the Society's Surveyors at Cardiff} Scullard will be instructed to join him in the survey of the vessel. and he should arrange to let Mr. Scullard know when ^{remaining to be lifted} all the ceiling and oxidation have been removed, the plating drilled as required by the Rules and the vessel otherwise prepared for examination.

The plating should be drilled as required by the Rules and in such places as to indicate its general condition and a sketch of the drillings should be forwarded to this Office as soon as possible for the consideration of the Committee, and should be accompanied with a statement as to whether in his opinion any doubling should be fitted or other compensation made for deterioration in the plating. He should not wait until the survey has been completed before forwarding this sketch.

Mr. Scullard, one of the Society's Surveyors at Cardiff should be requested to join Mr. Westcott, the Society's Surveyor at Appledore, in the 3rd S.S. No. 3 on this vessel at Appledore as soon as he receives intimation from Mr. Westcott that the vessel is ready for their joint survey.
