It is submitted that before this case receives the consideration of the Committee, the sketch of drillings should be ^{returned} ~~forwarded~~ to the surveyor and his attention should be called to the thicknesses noted thereon in pencil which are the original thicknesses as per first entry report.

In view of the diminution of thickness reported particularly on midship portion of strake No. 6, he should be requested to state whether the plating was drilled in locally wasted places, or if the thicknesses reported represent the general condition of the plating.

With regard to the request contained in Mr. Yeoman's letter regarding date of classification certificate, the surveyor should be requested to inform Mr. Yeoman that the request cannot be acceded to.
