Dear Sir,

I duly received your letter of the 19th instant relative to the case of your Barque 'Elliot', and note that the vessel is now on her way home from Iquique and that on her arrival at her discharging port you will determine what arrangements can be made for her submission to the 2nd Special Survey N.3.

In reply to your enquiry, I beg to say that as the Special Survey N.3 became due on this vessel in February last, the Society's Rules require the inspection to be carried out as soon as practicable. In

cases however where a vessel cannot be submitted to the requisite survey shortly after she came become due, the Rules allow twelve months from the date of it becoming due for its completion.
