

It appears from the Appledore Surveyors letter of 7 Dec^r 1907 that he has a charge for 15/- travelling expenses against the S.S. "New Zealand" recently lengthened and placed through S.S. No 3 at his port.

The fees collected in this case on account of Appledore & Cardiff and the Cardiff Surveyors travelling expenses amount to £34.5.2 (less 9/- discount on appledore fee) = £33.16.2

It is submitted that it is undesirable that any further application for fees should be made to the owners of this vessel and that Mr. Westcott, the Appledore Surveyor, should be authorised to debit the petty cash account of his office with the sum of 15/- due to him for expenses.

The fee of £1.1 for freeboard was collected in this office and should be ^{credited} ~~debited~~ to the Appledore Office.
