It is further submitted that the Appledore Surveyor should be satisfied that the plans forwarded by him having the proposed alterations to the iron steamer "aboard" are receiving consideration.

The Surveyor should point out to Messrs Cook & Sons that "New Zealand" is an iron steamer and not a canvas as stated by them on the application submitted for approval.

The Surveyor should also inform the owners or their representative that this case cannot be dealt with a view to the re-instatement of the classification unless the engines & boilers are submitted for survey.

The vessel must undergo the 2nd S.S. No 3 re-instatement of classification, in addition to additional strengthening, which may be found on account of lengthening. The surveyor should arrange for the drillings to be made of the stiff as required for that survey.

It is further submitted that if this re-instatement of class is proceeded with the Surveyor should be joined in the survey and the Senior Ship Surveyor at Cardiff be present.
