Sir,

With reference to your First Entry Report No. 2895 on the hull of the new steamer "PROVIDER", I have to request that you will be good enough to furnish me with an exact legible copy of the account for fees and expenses rendered by you to the Builders of this vessel as the entries on your Report are not clear and cannot be understood.

I have also to call your attention to Paragraph 1, Section 28 on page 29 of the Rules wherein it is required that the minimum Special Survey fee on First Entry shall be £7-0-0, and to state that if you have not yet forwarded your account to the Builders you should not do so until hearing further from me.

At the same time I am directed to request that you will explain the circumstances in which a charge of 30/- appears to have been made by you for travelling expenses and another charge of 10/- for night work.
