In answer to your letter of the 8<sup>th</sup> Inst<sup>ant</sup>, respecting the space of the Beams in the Barge "Trefs," I have to-day measured the space between each beam, and enclosed send you a rough sketch.

The four sister ships built since I have been here, namely - Mary Louisa, no 559, Barbara, 618, Agnes, 705, and Manuela, 773, have the same number of beams, except the Barbara, which has one beam more under the Cabin Deck.
