sternpost taken out and new bottoms welded on. (For particulars
of construction see plans herewith.)

Flat of bottom ceiled with Pitch Pine, bilges with Spruce
The whole of the vessel well cleaned and sealed where old plating
was left, and coated inside with red lead paint above bilges;
from bilge to bilge with Portland cement, and outside with black
varnish, & paint on topsides. Masts scraped and examined
cables ranged.
