Sir,

With reference to your letter of the 10th. instant forwarding one from Messrs Sumners & Scott respecting the fees charged for the survey of the screw tug No. 59, your report No. 5555, I have to acquaint you that the following fees should be charged in this case, viz:-

£1-0-0 entry fee for ship,
£3-8-0 special survey fee for ship,
£1-0-0 entry fee for machinery and
£3-0-0 special survey of machinery and boilers, making a total of £8-8-0, in addition to which the travelling expenses as incurred should be charged.

With reference to the case of No. 58 to which allusion is made, I have to point out that £9 was the fee for the survey of the engines and boilers, namely £5 at Bristol and £4 at Hull, so that you will see the fee charged in that case was of the amount prescribed in the Rules although not charged strictly under the proper head.

I return the accounts enclosed with your letter.
