In reply to enquiry the Owners stated that the survey ^{recently} ~~would~~ ^{would probably} be held on the vessel's return in about a fortnight, but they ~~will~~ ^{would} advise definitely later on.

The Owners now state that they have arranged to dock the vessel at Ardrossan, but as she is now bound for Kings Lynn, they propose sending her to Bilbao to load for Ardrossan, and trust this arrangement will be considered satisfactory.

A reply by wire is requested.

It is submitted the Owners be informed by wire that their proposal to send the vessel to Bilbao to load for Ardrossan ^{previous to holding the S.S. No. 3} is considered satisfactory.

In the meantime the class might be allowed to remain undisturbed.
