In compliance with the request contained in your telegram of this afternoon I enclose the first entry report on the steamer "DUNMAIL".

At the same time I have to acquaint you that it is understood the shaft tunnel bulkhead in this vessel is wasted through in holes, and that the deck plating is badly wasted and laminated, and I have to request that you will give special attention to these matters and report thereon to the Committee in due course.

I have to remind you that this vessel became due in May last for the Second Special Survey No. 3, and you should therefore endeavour to arrange for that Special Survey to be now held.
