I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of this date relative to your steamer "CORNWALL", and in reply to your enquiry, I have to state that Mr. Fowling, who visited this vessel when she was in dry dock at Barry, recommended as a permanent repair that a steel plate shoe, similar to the previous one $\frac{3}{4}$ " thick should be fitted to the sole piece of the stern frame.
