S I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of to-day's date relative to the case of your steamer "CORNWALL", and in reply to state that Mr. Fowling, one of the Assistants to the Chief Ship Surveyor, who joined in the survey of this vessel at Barry, reports that from the examination which he made of the stern frame on the 29th instant, no other repair is in his opinion necessary to efficiently deal with the damage referred to beyond the recommendation made that a steel shoe plate be fitted to the sole piece as a permanent repair.
