Dear Sir,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 14th instant relative to the classification in the Society's Register Book of your steamer "ATLANTIDE", and to acquaint you that the Committee have had the matter under consideration today together with a report from the Society's Surveyors at Barry of their recent survey of the steamer.

In reply I have to state that the Committee regret they are unable to acceded to your request to postpone the repairs to the shelter deck plating, and that as it appears that it is not your intention to do the necessary work before the steamer leaves Barry, the Committee have no alternative but to give instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Society's Register Book with a Black Line indicating that from reported defects the vessel is no longer eligible to retain her class.
