Sir,

I beg respectfully to state
that, Mr Davies Esq. of Cardigan
has transmitted to me a Certificate
from you with reference to the Building
and Coppering of the Ship
"Ann Willows" in October last, which
Certificate is very satisfactory.

But as the scot is sheathed
with wood under the same it is
necessary that the state of the wood
sheathing viz; - when put on and how
fastened should also be ascertained
so that a judgment may be formed

with regard to the inner skin
of the vessel, the turnails and
the caulkings thereof.

Should be glad if you would
directly or indirectly ^{assist} me in getting
the information sought for, as
the owners wish is to have the
Rule as regards the stripping of
the copper relaxed or otherwise
he feels he must give up the
idea of Clipping the Vessel.
