Sir,

With reference to your letter of the
26th Dec^r as regards 1226 "Ann Wilson" I beg
respectfully to acquaint you that the vessel
was opened yesterday in her bilges and at
second footlock heads as prescribed by the Rules.
— We (Mr John William Shipbinder and self) surveyed
the parts and found the vessel good.

At the Second Footlock heads we found
wood stops introduced for the purpose of retain-
ing salt between the timbers, having evidence
of the ship being previously well salted. And
at the gunwale listings cut between the
stanchions for salting & securing the frames.

The owner agree as requested to submit
the vessel &c — Agreement in writing trans-
mitted herewith, and two letters of correspondence
written previously to the exchange of ownership
being effected but, not seen by us before
yesterday. Therein is a simple statement
of the materials used in her construction,
& sent for the due consideration of the Committee.

Stem joints American White Oak.

The whole of the timber materials when
exposed to views is square edged of
bright appearances full of acids and
no defects whatever.

On after consideration on the whole I
think the Rules will admit of her claims
to be considered S. S. 71 for 5 years in lieu
of as before suggested S. S. 71 for 7 years.

And I beg to submit the same
for the Committee's due consideration
and approval or otherwise.
