

Barque "Ann Wilson" 431 Tons built
at Pembroke - United States in 1854

Surveyed by Mr. Bateman at Gardigan
and recommended for ~~7 A. 1.~~ in Red -

From the Reports now received
it will be seen that this vessel is
built ^{in part} of extremely low classed material,
and that she is 17 years old -

Section 51 and the Second Survey Rule
for A in Red have not been complied
with in the following instances viz:
The Yellow Metal and wood sheathing
have not been stripped off, the
planking from the wales to the light
water mark has not been brightened,
and planking or listing, equal to
one entire stake at the first futtock
heads has not been taken out -
nor does it appear that her fastenings
have been thoroughly examined
in accordance with the Rules -

I cannot therefore concur in Mr
Bateman's recommendation to class
her ~~7 A. 1.~~ in Red but I am of
opinion that the character ~~7 A. 1.~~
would better meet this case
