Sir,

I have to acquaint you that it appears from a report of survey received from the Society's Surveyors at Cardiff on the ~~the~~ barque "JOHN O'GAUNT" that to complete the Special Survey No. 3 the close ceiling from eight frame spaces abaft the fresh water tanks to the peak bulkhead requires to be removed, the peak and outside plating in way of side lights to be examined and the mast wedges removed.

The Owners state that the vessel is now on her passage from Coquimbo to Philadelphia, and is due to arrive in September next when the survey in question will be completed, and I shall therefore be glad for the case to receive your attention in due course.
