Reverting to your letter of 5th inst: with reference to the Bk "John O Gaunt" No 619 in the Register and to the Owners letter forwarded for our information, we beg now to state that the vessel has been examined in graving dock and internally as far as practicable and so far as seen is in good condition, the vessel has a large quantity of ballast on board and no part of ceiling has yet been lifted.

The plating has been drilled, the scantlings measured and the wasting so far as seen does not appear excessive.

We are of opinion that the application of the Owners to postpone the completion of the survey should have the favourable consideration of the

Committee.
