The S.S.No.3, due 3,04, was partly held at Cardiff in August last. To complete the survey the holds above close ceiling require to be examined, plating drilled if considered necessary, bunkers cleared and examined, tank in engine space scaled internally and the floors and intercostals in same examined, and the pumps, sluices and WT doors examined.

The Owners stated in March last that the vessel was then in Eastern Waters and they were trying to fix her home, when they would complete the survey. This proposal was before the Committee on the 31st March and action was deferred.

The Owners now state in reply to enquiry that the vessel is now discharging in Japan, and is afterwards fixed to load a cargo in China for the U.K. or Continent, and they intend, with the Committee's permission, to defer completion of the survey until her return home, and they trust the Committee will grant their request.

The year of grace expired at the end of March.

The Owners' proposal is submitted for the consideration of the Committee.
