The S.S.No.2 became due in July 1904, and was partly held at Cardiff in November 1904.

To complete the survey all the tanks require to be examined internally, side bunkers and E&B space examined and the tank in E&B space tested. & a new half condenser to be fitted

A proposal of the Owners in May last to postpone completion of the survey until the expiration of the vessel's charter in about four months time was agreed to by the Committee.

The Owners now state in reply to enquiry that the vessel is just now leaving Bombay for New York whence she will load homewards, and is expected to arrive in the U.K. towards the end of January when they will undertake to complete the survey.

The Owners proposal is submitted for the consideration of the Committee.
