The S.S.No.2 became due in July last and was partly held at Cardiff in November.

To complete the survey all the tanks require to be examined internally, side bunkers and E&B space examined and the tank in E&B space tested. *FLM.C.5-04 assigned BS due 5-05 held 7 05*

The Owners now state in reply to enquiry that the vessel is engaged on Time Charter in the Calcutta coal trade and they would prefer completion of the survey remaining over until her return home. They anticipate the charter will expire in about four months time when they will bring the vessel home direct and they trust the Committee will accede to their request.

The year of grace will expire at the end of July next.

The Owners proposal is submitted for the consideration of the Committee.
