Copy of Mr Ritchie's notes on the new ship  
"Seringapatam".

"No 1. a new ship, <sup>4507 tons,</sup> to be named the 'Seringa-  
patam'; building by Messrs John Scott & Sons Greenock.  
Planked outside and in, and decks laid. Nearly ready for  
launching. Outside plank below the wales, and ceiling  
generally, of mahogany, intended to clap 13A. for which  
she appears perfectly fit, with the exception of the up and  
down bolts of the upper deck hanging knees, which are iron,  
and as the deck is laid, required by the Rule to be of Yellow  
metal or copper. Mr Scott agreed that they should be  
renewed of yellow metal."
