


And upon 21 June 1850

I hereby certify, that we have supplied the  
Brig "Pioneer" of Salloway, belonging to  
Andrew Gell, & Co. with Chains and Anchors as under-  
noted; that the Chain Cables have been subjected to proof strains  
as follow, viz.—

The 1 inch Chain to a strain of 18 Tons, the 1 1/2 inch Chain to a  
strain of 22 Tons, and the 1 1/2 inch Chain to a strain of 7 1/2 Tons; and  
that on the last link of each fifteen fathoms the proof strain is  
marked as per margin.—
