

Wood / Barque "Panda" of 345  
tons, built at Aalborg (Denmark)  
and recommended to be classed 12A1.

The sketch of midship section  
of this vessel, setting forth the descrip-  
tion of materials to be used, and scant-  
lings, were submitted and approved  
previous to the commencement of her  
construction.

It is respectfully submitted  
that an error was inadvertently made  
by taking Danish oak as of the  
9 years grade for the whole of the Frame,  
whereas the Committee decided to class  
it with Continental oak in line 4 of  
Table A, - which does not admit of  
more than 8 years for 2<sup>nd</sup> futtocks and  
Top timbers.

In view of the fact that the  
Builders were informed that the ma-  
terials proposed would render this vessel  
eligible for the class recommended, it is  
respectfully submitted that it is a case  
for the favorable consideration of the  
Committee to assign the class recommended,  
with a provision that it is not to be  
drawn into a precedent.

Should the Committee entertain  
favorably this submission, the vessel would  
be eligible to be classed 12A1 and

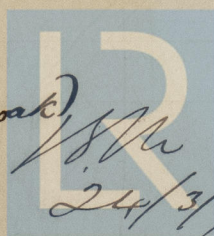
