Sir,

With reference to the case of the steamer "HERAKLES" (your Report No.1062) built under your Special Survey at Elsinore in 1897, I have to remind you that this vessel was classed by the Committee subject to the first and second bower anchors being tested at a recognised machine , and that in your letter of the 4th January last year you stated that the Builders intended getting the anchors tested at Stockholm.

Under the circumstances, I have to request you will kindly ascertain definitely for the Committee's information what steps are intended to be taken in the matter in view of the length of time which has now elapsed since the vessel was classed.
