Dear Mr. Milton

I received your esteemed favor of 6th inst - returning my reports on Electric Lighting on S/s "Herakles" - and have now made the required additions and have remeasured the sizes of Cables, wires &c - and have entered same in square inches on the enclosed Reports. I think now all is correct and as per Rules. -

Please notice that in the most cases the number of Amperes had been given far too high, hence the cables appeared small - and also that in the Power Installation - the currents are alternating, hence only about 70 % of the 116 & 57 Amperes respectively pass through at any time. -

I thank You for your private letter and ^{the} hints on the question, and ask You kindly to excuse the trouble I have caused, - & I remain -
