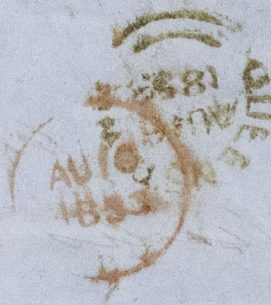
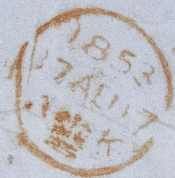

She was built for the 7 year grade, and so far as I could see, she has the materials for that grade, but not having been opened about the First Farthoth's heads as per Rule, as the Rules of the First Farthoths not saying close to the keelsons, or instead, the Lumber Stakes not having been bolted thereby, (with these exceptions she would be entitled to the 7 year grade), therefore I leave it with the Committee to give her that if entitled to it.
