Gentlemen

With reference to the application made by you in your letter of the 12th ultimo for an improvement of the Classification granted to the Brig "Tone", 237 tons, on account of her being salted, I have to acquaint you that it appears by the reports received from the Society's Surveyors as Surveyors of the salting of the vessel, that it has not been done in accordance with the requirements of the Rules for the assignment of another year to her term of classification, and therefore the Committee have not felt it in their power to accede to your wishes in this respect.

I am at the same time to add that on the completion of the Salting and the receipt of a satisfactory report thereon the Committee will be prepared
