Wood Brig "Done" of 237 Tons
built at Cork and launched in
October 1877 and only lately completed.

The Owners request that the class
may commence from the date of
completion of the vessel instead of
Oct 1877 the date of launching.

The case was reported upon last Thursday
when the Committee decided that the
date of launching should be recorded in
the Register Book.

The Owners now solicit the Committee
to reconsider this decision and they also
request that the class to which the
vessel will be eligible on the completion
of the Salting may be assigned, and
they undertake to complete the
Salting immediately on the return
of the vessel from her present voyage.

It is respectfully submitted that
the Salting is very nearly completed,
the only part ^{left} being behind the waterway,
the Owners doing all that was requested
by the Surveyor, under these circumstances,
the Owners application in regard to the Salting
appears to merit the favorable consideration
of the Committee, and should they entertain
this the vessel would be eligible to be Classed
as of



as follows viz: 10 yrs for material
and 1 year salt
11 A. I.

The application respecting the date
of launching is respectfully left
for the Committee's consideration.
